- 03/2024 Could the Hon. Minister for Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation inform this Honourable House about the overall financial status of the Eswatini Embassy to the United Nations, including the reports that staff goes for months without salaries?

- (c) If the Hon. Minister has ever met Principals from these schools to get first-hand information about their concerns?
- (d) Plans for 2026 after the programme ends in 2025.
